

## Arrival Meeting

Attend your *Arrival Meeting* within 60 calendar days of your Temporary Work Permit (TWP) Issuance date.

Be sure to provide copies of the following documents for your *Arrival Report* meeting:

- The principal applicant's passport: Photocopies of pages containing photo and biographical data, your stamp of entry into Canada, and last page containing your signature;
- Temporary Work Permit: A photocopy of your TWP, including the date issued and the expiry date;
- A photocopy of your Nova Scotia Driver's License or NS ID card if applicable;
- A photocopy of your Nova Scotia Health Card if applicable;
- Proof of your address in Nova Scotia. This can include:
  - A scanned copy of utility bills in your name;
  - A scanned copy of any lease agreement you have signed; and
  - A scanned copy of your mortgage or purchase agreement if you have purchased a house.

Proof of funds transfer to Canada: You'll have to show proof that you've transferred the amount specified in your Business Performance Agreement to a bank account in Nova Scotia. This proof can include:

- A scanned copy of your bank statement showing the withdrawal from your bank account in your home country and a photocopy of your bank statement showing the deposit into your bank account in Nova Scotia; or
- A scanned copy of your funds transfer showing the account the money was withdrawn from and the Nova Scotia account money was transferred to.
