As of April 26, 2024

- Flexibility to prove official language abilities. A language test is not mandatory.
- > The Pearson Test of English (PTE) Core is accepted as proof of language ability.
- > Editing changes for clarity and consistency.

As of December 7, 2023

> Candidates may be between the ages of 19 and 55.

As of September 22, 2023

NOC 32102 (Paramedical occupations) and NOC 32124 (Pharmacy technicians) are eligible.

As of November 16, 2022

- We're switching to the 2021 version of the National Occupational Classification (NOC). This means that:
 - the NOC 2016 skill type and skill level structure (NOC 0, A, B, C and D) will be replaced with a 6-category system representing the training, education, experience and responsibilities (TEER) needed to work in an occupation, and
 - 4-digit occupation codes will become 5-digit codes.
