

Physician Application Guide Changes

As of November 16, 2022

- We're switching to the 2021 version of the National Occupational Classification (NOC). This means that:
 - the NOC 2016 skill type and skill level structure (NOC O, A, B, C and D) will be replaced with a 6-category system representing the training, education, experience and responsibilities (TEER) needed to work in an occupation
 - 4-digit occupation codes will become 5-digit codes

As of Dec. 1, 2020

- Editing changes for clarity and consistency.

As of Nov. 23, 2018

- A one-time re-issuance of a nomination may be granted on a case-by-case basis.

As of July 10, 2018

- The When Not to Apply section has been updated and no longer excludes applicants who are:
 - the spouse of an international student at a Canadian post-secondary institution who is not in his/her last academic year of studies.
